Please see the schedule below and discuss with your child how important it is to celebrate the differences we share!



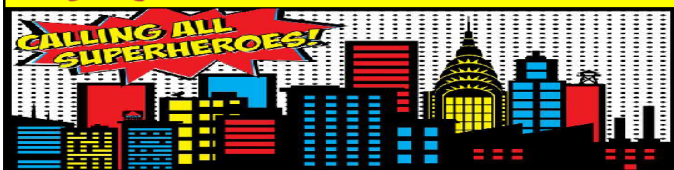
Best Friends!!
